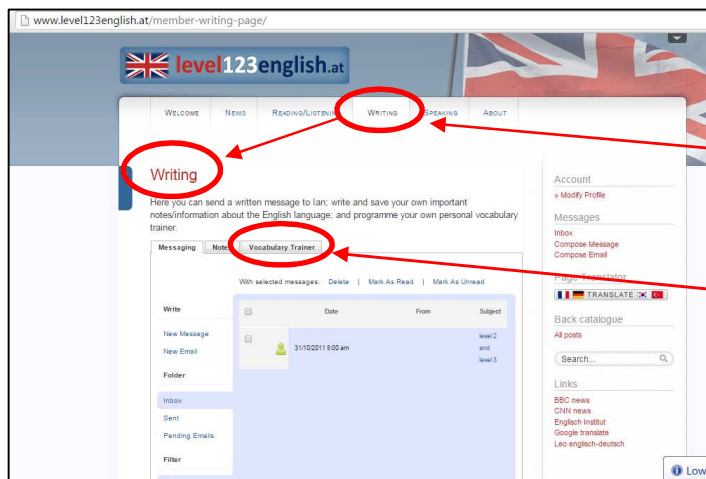


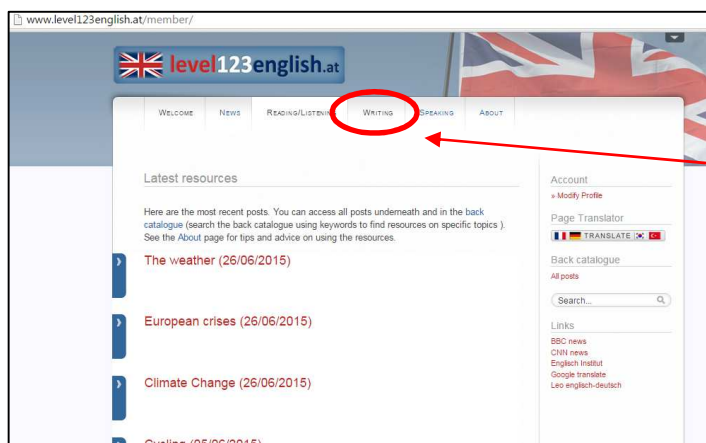
How to use the level123english Vocabulary Trainer

a) As a subscribed User: go to 'Writing' page and click on 'Vocabulary trainer'



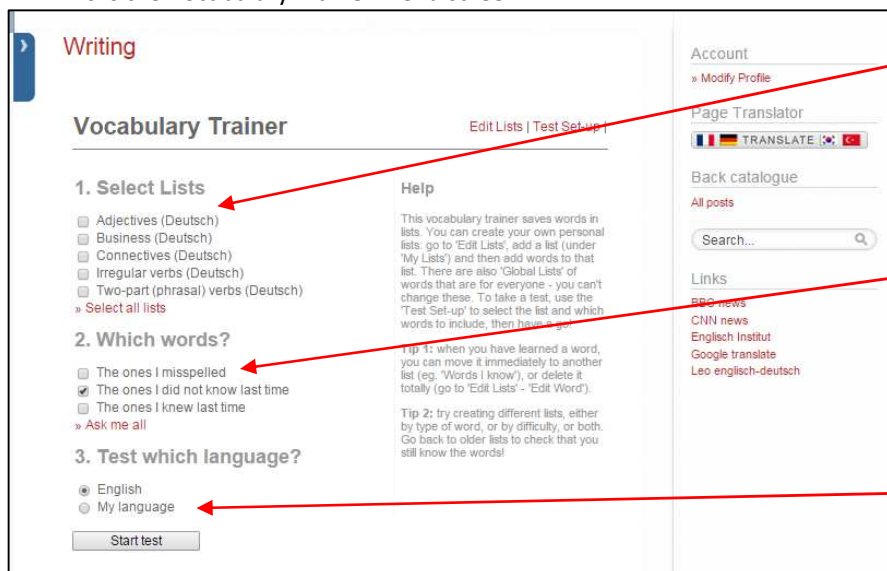
1. Click on 'Writing' tab to go to 'Writing' page
2. Click on 'Vocabulary trainer' tab to go to the Vocabulary Trainer

b) As a free User: go to Writing page and you will go to the vocabulary trainer page



1. Click on 'Writing' tab to go to the Vocabulary Trainer

This is the Vocabulary Trainer menu screen:




The tests are based on **lists**. There are some 'global lists' which you cannot edit, but you can also create your own lists with your own words.


There are three options for which words in a list you will be tested on. For example, you can choose to be tested only on the words you didn't know last time.

You can also choose which language you want to be tested on.




To take a test...




1. Select the list you want
2. Select which words you want the test to include
3. Select the language you want
4. Click 'Start test'



5. Enter the word/s in the box
6. Click 'Go' or 'Don't know'
7. See if you were right ('Correct') or wrong ('You wrote: ...')

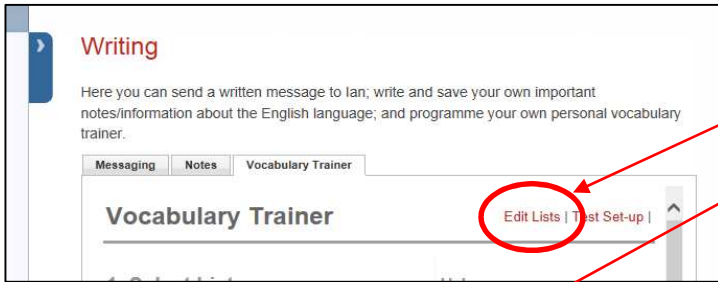
You have 5 tries before you see this screen with the answer and the next word.



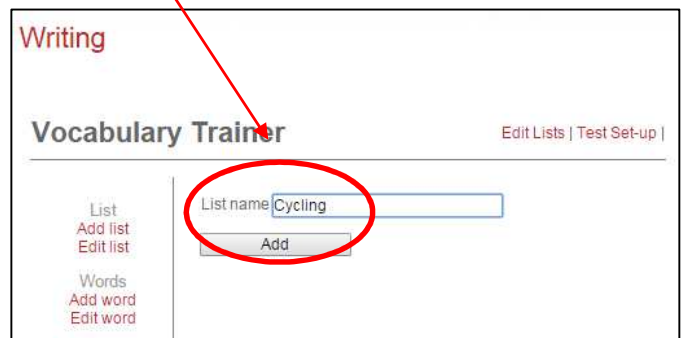
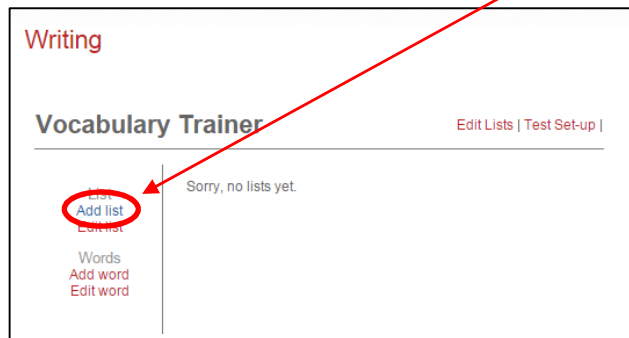
At the end of a test, you will see your score.

8. You can
 - a) repeat the test
 - b) repeat only the words you didn't know, or
 - c) go back to the 'set up' menu.

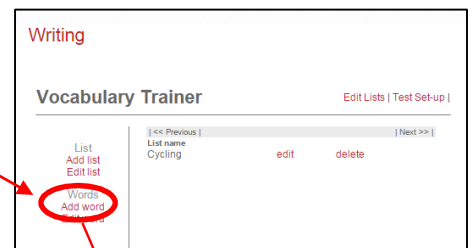
To set up your own list of words...



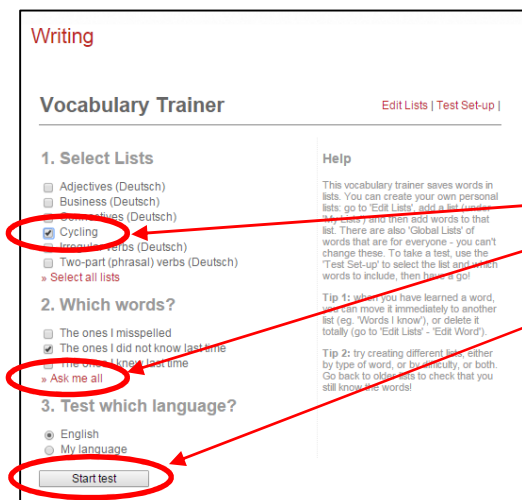
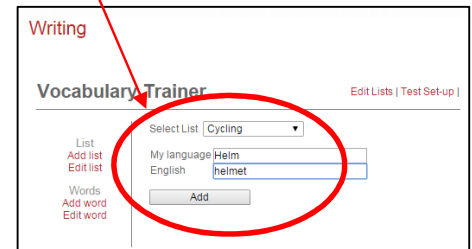
1. Click on 'Edit Lists'
2. Click on 'Add List'
3. Enter a name for your list and click 'Add'



4. Click 'Add word' and you will see the name of the list in a drop-down menu. Select the list you want.



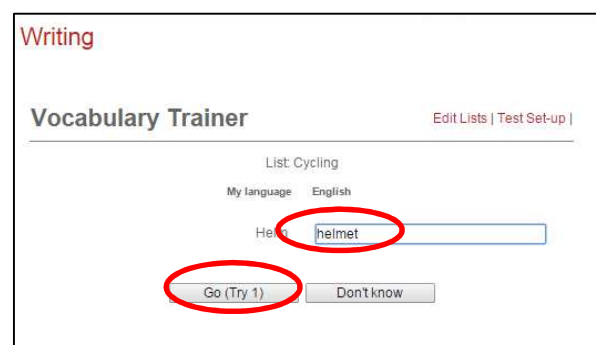
5. Select the right list, then add your word – in both languages. Click 'Add' and the programme will automatically save the word. You can keep on adding words. At the end, click 'Test set-up' to finish.



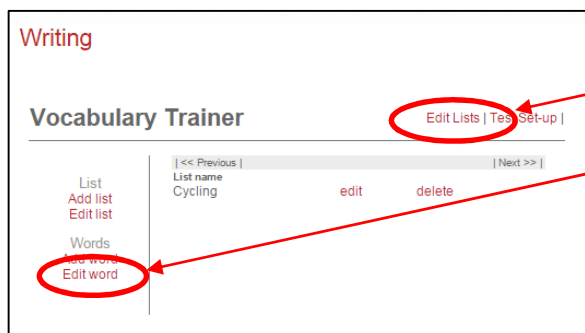
6. Now you can select your list and words...

...and start the test...

...and continue as for any test (described above).

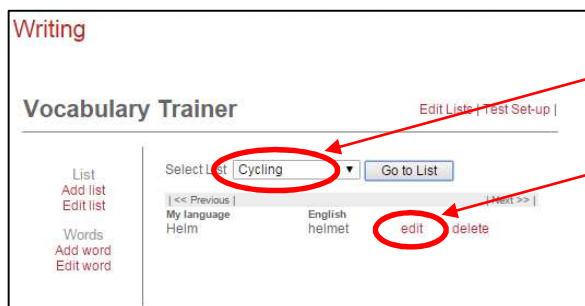


To change the words in your lists...



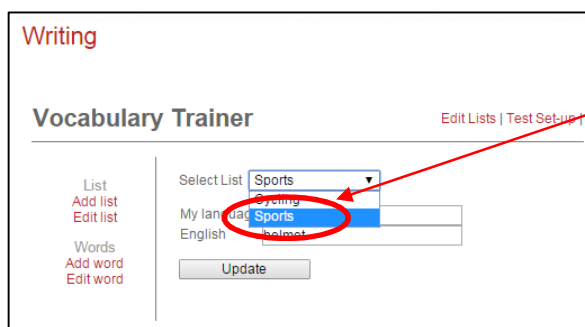
1. Go to the 'Edit Lists' screen

2. and then click on 'Edit word'



3. Select one of your lists

4. and then click on 'edit' for the word you want to move.



5. You can move the word to a different list of your choice...

...or change the spelling of the word.

6. Click on 'Update' when you have finished. Your changes will be saved automatically.

7. You can go to 'Test Set-up' to start another test, or choose to edit more words/lists.

Tips:

- The Vocabulary Trainer can only recognise 'standard' letters. So, please don't try to use a *ü* or a *ö*, but instead write *ue* or *oe*.
- Typing words into lists is a good way to start learning them!
- You could create lists of 'easy words' that you can remember, or 'difficult words'.
- You could create lists for different topics – learning related words together will help you to remember them when you need them.
- You can create as many lists as you like, and move words between lists as often as you like. The Vocabulary Trainer is yours to use how you want to. Have fun!
